

Our **Environmental Mission Statement** is to respect the environment, cherish nature and do what is good for the planet.

Cutlery

Our cutlery is from the company Eco Iceland and the products are environmentally friendly, not only because they are made from organic and biodegradable materials, but the production process is also such that it does not have much impact on the environment.

Our dishes and cutlery are made from wheat bran and water. About 10.000 dishes, bowls and cutlery can be produced from one ton of wheat bran and a small amount of water and will break down in the environment within 30 days.

Our drinking glasses are made of corn and therefore they are compostable, biodegradable, eco-friendly and recyclable.

Our coffee cups are PE or Plant based cups, that is a certification for 100% plant based cardboard cup. Sugar cane, a plant-based coating for high-quality paper cup sealing, is also 100% GMO free. Also used is an environmentally friendly colour which is basically made from vegetable oil. All remaining paper is classified and recycled. The cups are compostable, biodegradable and recyclable.

Napkins

Our napkins are from Duni and they are Nordic certified, with an OK compost stamp confirming that all products and packaging comply with the EN 13432 standard.

Duni is an FSC certified company. All the resins have certifications that their bleaching goes either to a TCF (Totally chlorine free) or ECF (Elementary Chlorine Free).

Duni has The Green DOT, which means that customers who see the logo know that the manufacturer of the product contributes to the cost of recycling.

Thin napkins can go into organic classification and they use organic dyes and inks.

All Duni factories have the ISO 14001 quality certification.

Coffee

Our coffee is UTZ certified coffee. UTZ is an international standard for socially and environmentally responsible coffee production, sustainable production, cultivation and distribution.
